CEN/ISSS Focus Group Biometrics

- **Aim** - Overview of Biometrics standards issues with particular emphasis on ISO/IEC/JTC1/SC37
- **Output** - a report on European specific requirements in Biometrics work by 2005/05.
 - proposals for standardization work items at European level only (e.g. delivering CWAs) but possibly also new work items in JTC1/SC37 should not be excluded
- **Next steps** – Meeting on 26 January 2005
- **Membership** - Open

CEN/ISSS WS eAuthentication

- **Aim** – to provide an open forum to assist a coordinated approach towards the functionality of electronic cardholder Identification, Authentication and Digital signature mechanisms in the EU
- **Output** – A number of CWAs based on the eESC Global Interoperability Framework (due end 2004)
- **Next steps** – Public comment phase to start soon on CEN web
- **Membership** – Open with 500€ fee

CEN/ISSS WS Data Protection and Privacy

- **Aim** –to help business in Europe to comply with the Data Protection Directive and relevant national legislation by facilitating harmonization of practice, developing the understanding and predictability of detailed or sector practices
- **Output** – CWAs on:
 - Generic contract clauses,
 - Common European voluntary best practices for data controllers and data processors
 - Assessment of data protection audit practice
 - Technology impact analysis
- **Next steps**
 - Public comment starts next week on CEN web
 - Open meeting on 1 December
- **Membership** – Open with 600€ fee

CEN/TC224/WG15

- European Citizen card

- **Aim** - to define a concept of a citizen card, the ECC, being a smart card issued under the authority of a government institution, either national or local.
- **Output** – CEN Technical Specification
- **Next Steps** – First draft for Enquiry by end May 2005
- **Membership** – Through CEN National Standards Bodies

ICTSB Network and Information Security Steering Group (NISSG)

- **Aim** - To act as an overall focal point for the European standardization community on network and information security issues
- **Output** – To ensure the implementation of the NIS report produced by the CEN/ETSI NIS Group
- **Next steps**
 - Meetings 12 October 2004, 9 March 2005, 1 June 2005
 - Any issues regarding new activities (as distinct from issues concerning existing ones, wherever they may be) should be addressed to NISSG as the focal point
- **Membership** - open to any ICTSB member organization and their relevant technical groups and invited stakeholder interests

Next Steps

- Objective: Agree rough dates for next actions by COPRAS and projects. Include a date for a proposed Standardisation Action Plan draft before Christmas, and other items including:
 - Discussion within project consortium (if needed),
 - Review and agreement on Standardisation Action Plan,
 - Further coordination meeting to discuss technical topics in 2005 (or sooner).
