# Kick-off meeting – targeted objectives (1)

- Jump start cooperation between selected projects and standardization working group
- Share information on ongoing standardization work projects can benefit from and define what relevant standardization working groups are actually planning to do in the areas identified;

- Define the actual nature of planned contributions (i.e. formal specifications, guidelines, other contributions, etc.);
- Identify the right people within the research project consortia actually working on specific standards issues

- Define follow-up steps

# Kick-off meeting – targeted objectives (2)

- To prepare a basis for COPRAS WP4 – develop Tailor-made Standardisation Action Plans with projects
  - Identify steps to be taken by projects and standards bodies
  - Provide a realistic path towards standardization based on the experience and support of COPRAS
  - Identify realistic objectives in view of available resources
  - Define technical & dissemination activities
  - Define tasks to be completed by projects and COPRAS
