

West University of Timisoara

### Timisoara









- 3<sup>rd</sup> town in RO in no. inhabitants
  - 300 000 inhabitants + 50 000 students
  - around 10 000 employed in IT
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> biggest airport in the country
- Most open-minded and western-like town of RO
  - Started the revolution from 1989 against communists
- Particularities
  - "Town of flowers" and gardens, oldest brewery in Romania
  - ▶ "Little Wien", Austrian architecture; majority Germans until 2<sup>nd</sup> world war
  - Used as "testbed" for Austrian experiments: electrical street illumination, trams, gardening, channels etc

## Venue – West University of Timisoara

- Public university, located in the center of the town
- ▶ 11 Faculties, around 20 000 students
- Host: Computer Science Department
  - Associated with: Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science
  - Around 800 students in Computer Science (undergraduate, master, PhD)
  - ▶ 1/4 studying in English
  - Owner of THE supercomputing center of country
  - Vice-rector for research in 2012-2016: member CS Dep.& organizing team

  - 3.5 h with micro-buses from Budapest


#### Others:

- Bucharest 5 daily trains (9 h)
- From the airport to the hotels (12 km)
  - Hotels shuttles
  - Group pick up by the university bus
  - Bus & taxis

#### Our recommendations:


- Timisoara, 4\*,
  - > 209 rooms,
  - IN the center of the city
  - > 10 min walk from conference)
- Perla 4\*,
  - ▶ 100 rooms
  - complex of 3 hotels, swimming pool,
  - > 7 min from university, 12 from city center
- Savoy 4\*,
  - > 54 rooms,
  - closest to the center and university: 5 minutes walk from each
- NH Timisoara 4\*,
  - > 83 rooms
  - > 15 min walking from university or center
- Continental, 4\*,
  - ▶ 164 rooms
  - 15 min walking from university, 10 from center

#### Prices:

- Highest: 60 Euros (4\*),
- Lowest: 15 Euros (2\*)


