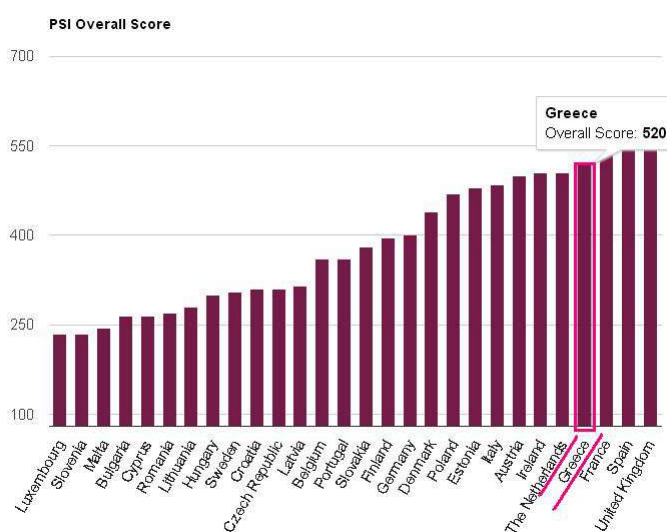

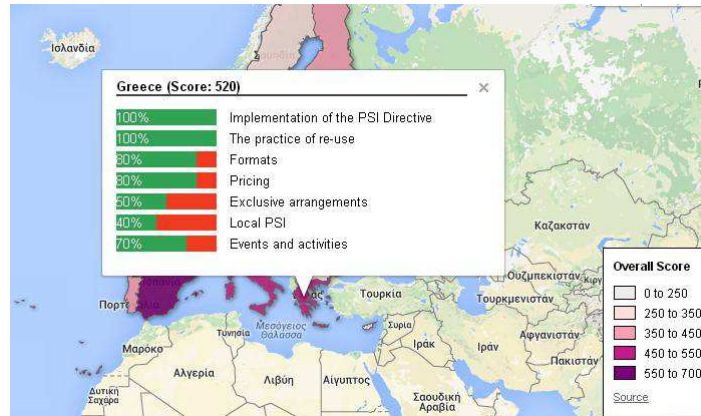

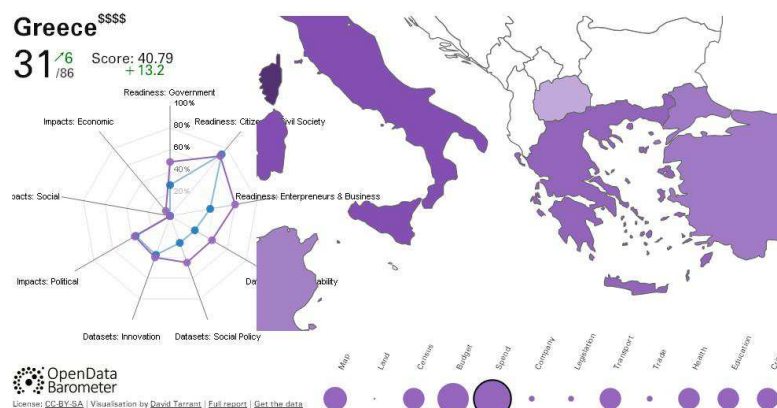
PSI scoreboard



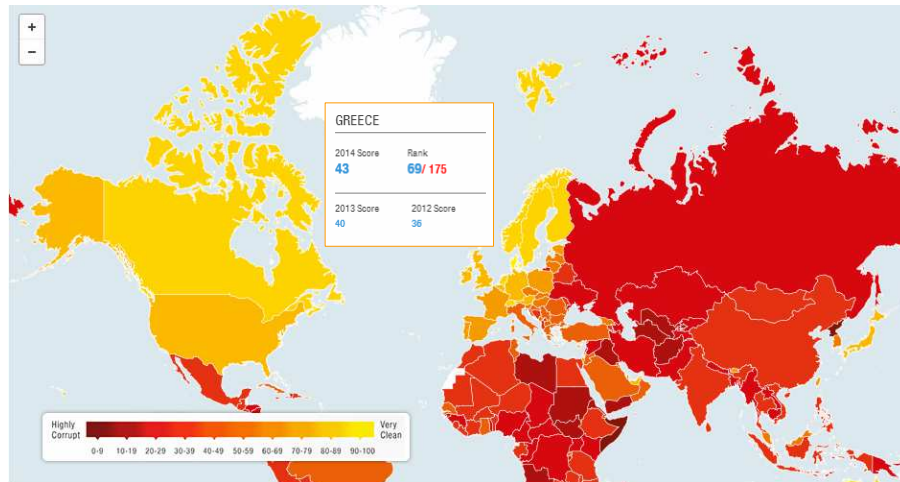

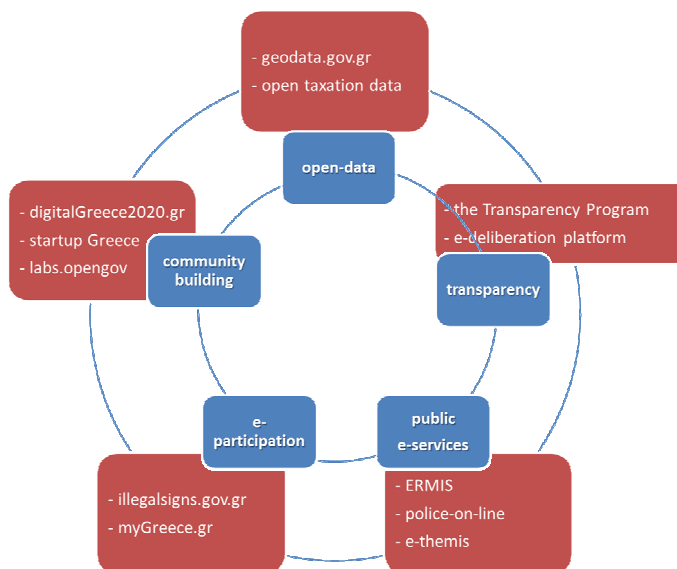
web index – open data barometer

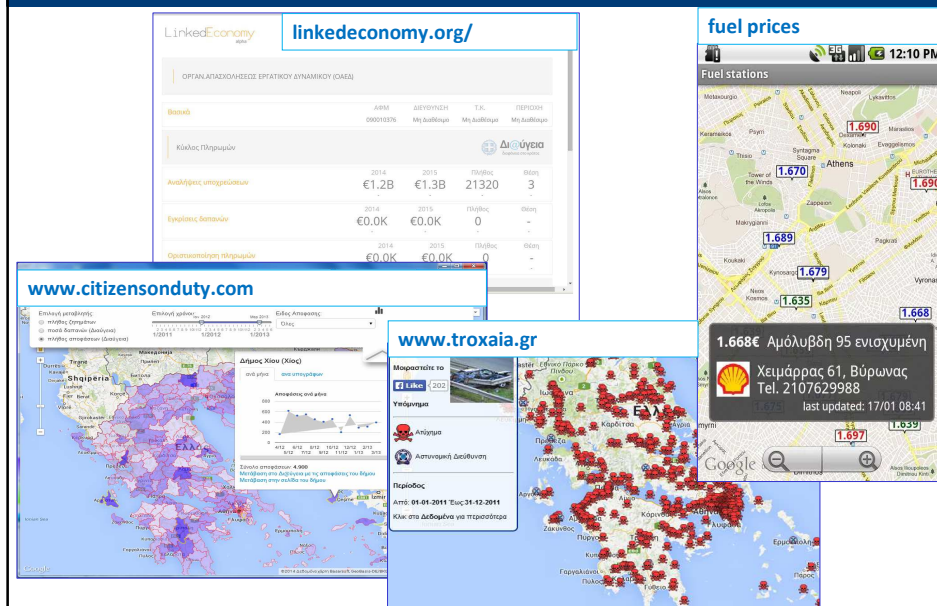

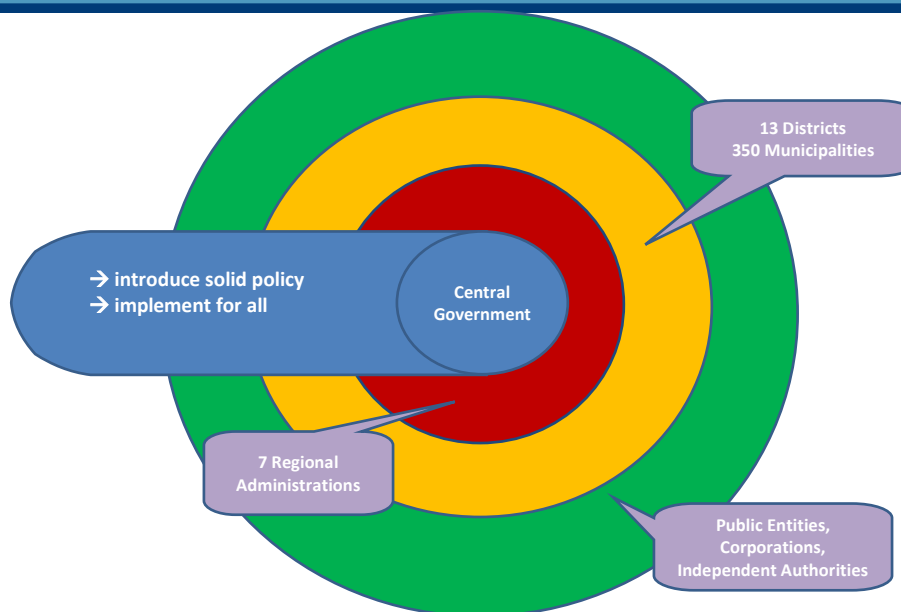
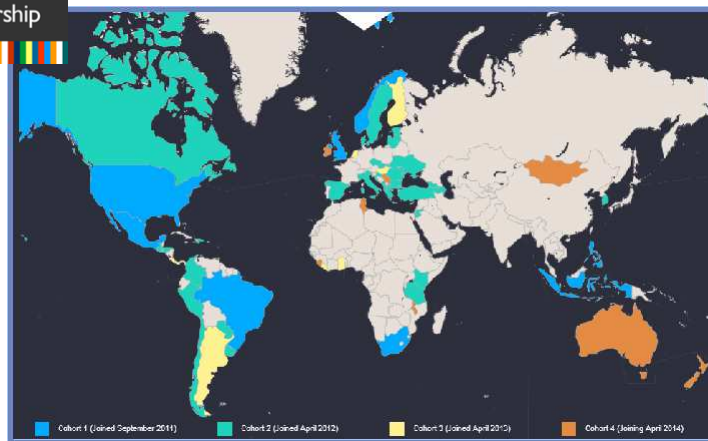

until now →

access to public sector information was given following a formal request

aim →

make PSI available freely and “open by default” for further use, both for commercial and non-commercial purposes, unless access is restricted or prohibited under specific purposes

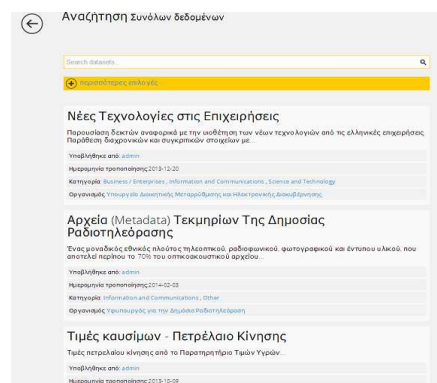
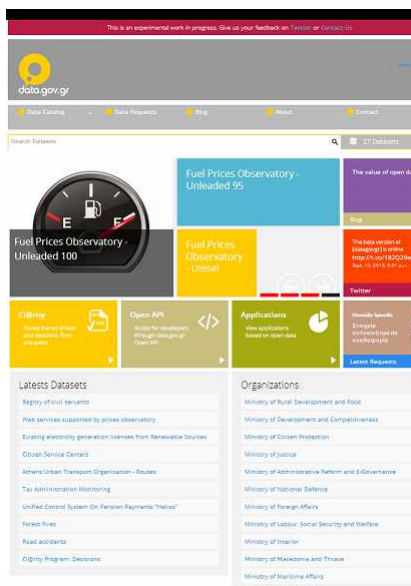
create a central PSI datasets registry

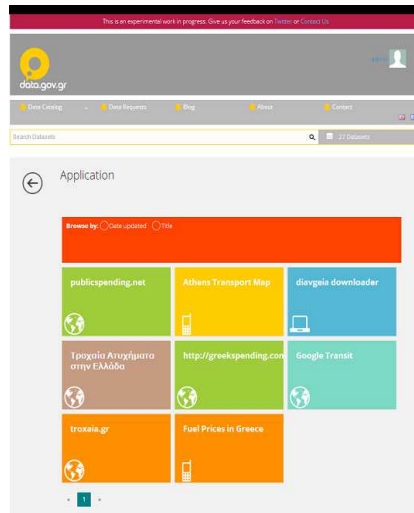
- all PAs record and publish their datasets and any restrictions or charges applied – at least annual update
- if PAs do not publish their decision before the deadline, all datasets are considered open and free of charge - subject to the provisions on the protection of personal data
- include libraries, museums, archives
- new obligation for independent authorities
- introduce new terms and definitions of new concepts "document in machine-readable format", "open format", “official open standard”
- detail charging rules, permits and fees
- introduce controlling mechanism to check compliance with the law provisions

Inspectors-Controllers Body for Public Administration, I.C.B.P.A.

Centralized platform to Gather and Publish

- structured sets of documents, information and data
- links to the websites of organizations where these are kept and maintained







transparency in public administration

Project Task Forces

hierarchical network of 4.221 teams has been established across the Public Sector, coordinating, implementing the Transparency Program and communicating its merits

bottom-up approach

- action and results' oriented management teams
- close cooperation with parallel formal organizational structures
- open call selection process – attracted only the best and the brave
- leaders of the Ministries' PTFs form a Joint Task Force

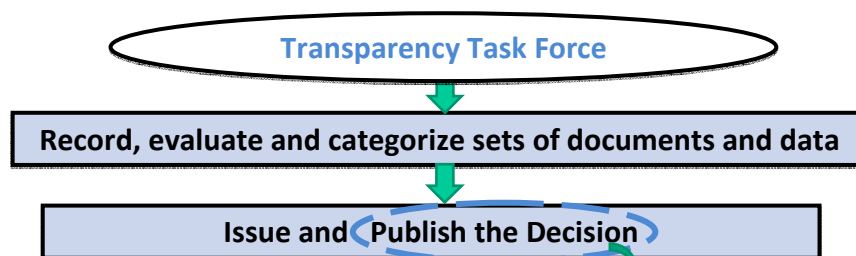
role

→ according to the new law, these teams will be the implementers of the new opendata policy in the public sector

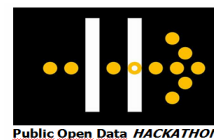
