## Thing > CreativeWork > Article > Discussion

An Internet forum / message board / online discussion site where people can hold conversations in the form of posted messages.

<strong>Properties from Thing</strong>		
<code>description</code>	Text	A short description of the item.
<code>image</code>	URL	URL of an image of the item.
<code>name</code>	Text	The name of the item.
<code>url</code>	URL	URL of the item.
<strong>Properties from CreativeWork</strong>		
<code>about</code>	Thing	The subject matter of the content.
<code>accountablePerson</code>	Person	Specifies the Person that is legally accountable for the CreativeWork.
<code>aggregateRating</code>	AggregateRating	The overall rating, based on a collection of reviews or ratings, of the item.
<code>alternativeHeadline</code>	Text	A secondary title of the CreativeWork.
<code>associatedMedia</code>	MediaObject	The media objects that encode this creative work. This property is a synonym for encodings.
<code>audio</code>	AudioObject	An embedded audio object.
<code>author</code>	Person or Organization	The author of this content. Please note that author is special in that HTML 5 provides a special mechanism

		for indicating authorship via the rel tag. That is equivalent to this and may be used interchangably.
<b>awards</b>	Text	Awards won by this person or for this creative work.
<b>comment</b>	<b>UserComments</b>	Comments, typically from users, on this CreativeWork.
<b>contentLocation</b>	<b>Place</b>	The location of the content.
<b>contentRating</b>	Text	Official rating of a piece of content—for example, 'MPAA PG-13'.
<b>contributor</b>	<b>Person</b> or <b>Organization</b>	A secondary contributor to the CreativeWork.
<b>copyrightHolder</b>	<b>Person</b> or <b>Organization</b>	The party holding the legal copyright to the CreativeWork.
<b>copyrightYear</b>	Number	The year during which the claimed copyright for the CreativeWork was first asserted.
<b>creator</b>	<b>Person</b> or <b>Organization</b>	First post contributor – The creator/author of this thread. This is the same as the Author property for CreativeWork.
<b>dateCreated</b>	Date	The date on which the CreativeWork was created.
<b>dateModified</b>	Date	The date on which the CreativeWork was most recently modified.
<b>datePublished</b>	Date	Date of first broadcast/publication.
<b>discussionUrl</b>	URL	A link to the page containing the comments of the CreativeWork.
<b>editor</b>	<b>Person</b>	Specifies the Person who edited the CreativeWork.
<b>encodings</b>	<b>MediaObject</b>	The media objects that encode this creative work
<b>genre</b>	Text	Genre of the creative work
<b>headline</b>	Text	Headline of the article

<b>inLanguage</b>	Text	The language of the content. please use one of the language codes from the <a href="#">IETF BCP 47 standard</a> .
<b>interactionCount</b>	Text	A count of a specific user interactions with this item—for example, 20 UserLikes, 5 UserComments, or 300 UserDownloads. The user interaction type should be one of the sub types of <a href="#">UserInteraction</a> .
<b>isFamilyFriendly</b>	Boolean	Indicates whether this content is family friendly.
<b>keywords</b>	Text	The keywords/tags used to describe this content.
<b>mentions</b>	Thing	Indicates that the CreativeWork contains a reference to, but is not necessarily about a concept.
<b>offers</b>	Offer	An offer to sell this item—for example, an offer to sell a product, the DVD of a movie, or tickets to an event.
<b>provider</b>	Person or Organization	Specifies the Person or Organization that distributed the CreativeWork.
<b>publisher</b>	Organization	The publisher of the creative work.
<b>publishingPrinciples</b>	URL	Link to page describing the editorial principles of the organization primarily responsible for the creation of the CreativeWork.
<b>reviews</b>	Review	Review of the item.
<b>sourceOrganization</b>	Organization	The Organization on whose behalf the creator was working.
<b>thumbnailUrl</b>	URL	A thumbnail image relevant to the Thing.
<b>version</b>	Number	The version of the CreativeWork embodied by a specified resource.
<b>video</b>	VideoObject	An embedded video object.

articleBody	Text	The actual body of the article.
articleSection	Text	Articles may belong to one or more sections in a magazine or newspaper. Example – Lifestyle, sports.
wordCount	Integer	The number of words in the text of an article.
<b>Properties from Discussion</b>		
attachment	URL	Link to <b>post</b> attachment(s)
discussionState	Text	Describes state of entire <b>thread</b> : Answered, UnAnswered
interestCount	Integer	Number of users interested in <b>thread</b>
postCount	Integer	Number of posts in a <b>thread</b>
postType	Text	Describes an individual <b>post</b> : Reply, Comment, Answer, Best Answer (as voted by the community), Initial, Last, Question
positiveVotes	Integer	Sum positive votes for a community <b>post</b> .
negativeVotes	Integer	Sum negative votes for a community <b>post</b> .
