## Thing > CreativeWork > Article > Discussion

An Internet forum / message board / online discussion site where people can hold conversations in the form of posted messages.

Properties from <b>Thing</b>		
<b>description</b>	Text	A short description of the item.
<b>image</b>	URL	URL of an image of the item.
<b>name</b>	Text	The name of the item.
<b>url</b>	URL	URL of the item.
Properties from <b>CreativeWork</b>		
<b>about</b>	<b>Thing</b>	The subject matter of the content.
<b>accountablePerson</b>	<b>Person</b>	Specifies the Person that is legally accountable for the CreativeWork.
<b>aggregateRating</b>	<b>AggregateRating</b>	The overall rating, based on a collection of reviews or ratings, of the item.
<b>alternativeHeadline</b>	Text	A secondary title of the CreativeWork.
<b>associatedMedia</b>	<b>MediaObject</b>	The media objects that encode this creative work. This property is a synonym for encodings.
<b>audio</b>	<b>AudioObject</b>	An embedded audio object.
<b>author</b>	<b>Person</b> or <b>Organization</b>	The author of this content. Please note that author is special in that HTML 5 provides a special mechanism

		for indicating authorship via the rel tag. That is equivalent to this and may be used interchangeably.
awards	Text	Awards won by this person or for this creative work.
comment	UserComments	Comments, typically from users, on this CreativeWork.
contentLocation	Place	The location of the content.
contentRating	Text	Official rating of a piece of content—for example, 'MPAA PG-13'.
contributor	Person or Organization	A secondary contributor to the CreativeWork.
copyrightHolder	Person or Organization	The party holding the legal copyright to the CreativeWork.
copyrightYear	Number	The year during which the claimed copyright for the CreativeWork was first asserted.
creator	Person or Organization	First post contributor – The creator/author of this thread. This is the same as the Author property for CreativeWork.
dateCreated	Date	The date on which the CreativeWork was created.
dateModified	Date	The date on which the CreativeWork was most recently modified.
datePublished	Date	Date of first broadcast/publication.
discussionUrl	URL	A link to the page containing the comments of the CreativeWork.
editor	Person	Specifies the Person who edited the CreativeWork.
encodings	MediaObject	The media objects that encode this creative work
genre	Text	Genre of the creative work
headline	Text	Headline of the article

<code>inLanguage</code>	Text	The language of the content. please use one of the language codes from the <b>IETF BCP 47 standard</b> .
<code>interactionCount</code>	Text	A count of a specific user interactions with this item—for example, 20 <code>UserLikes</code> , 5 <code>UserComments</code> , or 300 <code>UserDownloads</code> . The user interaction type should be one of the sub types of <b>UserInteraction</b> .
<code>isFamilyFriendly</code>	Boolean	Indicates whether this content is family friendly.
<code>keywords</code>	Text	The keywords/tags used to describe this content.
<code>mentions</code>	<b>Thing</b>	Indicates that the <code>CreativeWork</code> contains a reference to, but is not necessarily about a concept.
<code>offers</code>	<b>Offer</b>	An offer to sell this item—for example, an offer to sell a product, the DVD of a movie, or tickets to an event.
<code>provider</code>	<b>Person</b> or <b>Organization</b>	Specifies the <b>Person</b> or <b>Organization</b> that distributed the <code>CreativeWork</code> .
<code>publisher</code>	<b>Organization</b>	The publisher of the creative work.
<code>publishingPrinciples</code>	URL	Link to page describing the editorial principles of the organization primarily responsible for the creation of the <code>CreativeWork</code> .
<code>reviews</code>	<b>Review</b>	Review of the item.
<code>sourceOrganization</code>	<b>Organization</b>	The <b>Organization</b> on whose behalf the creator was working.
<code>thumbnailUrl</code>	URL	A thumbnail image relevant to the <b>Thing</b> .
<code>version</code>	Number	The version of the <code>CreativeWork</code> embodied by a specified resource.
<code>video</code>	<b>VideoObject</b>	An embedded video object.

<code>articleBody</code>	Text	The actual body of the article.
<code>articleSection</code>	Text	Articles may belong to one or more sections in a magazine of newspaper. Example – Lifestyle, sports.
<code>wordCount</code>	Integer	The number of words in the text of an article.
Properties from <b>Discussion</b>		
<code>attachment</code>	URL	Link to <b>post</b> attachment(s)
<code>discussionState</code>	Text	Describes state of entire <b>thread</b> : Answered, UnAnswered
<code>interestCount</code>	Integer	Number of users interested in <b>thread</b>
<code>postCount</code>	Integer	Number of posts in a <b>thread</b>
<code>postType</code>	Text	Describes an individual <b>post</b> : Reply, Comment, Answer, Best Answer (as voted by the community), Initial, Last, Question
<code>positiveVotes</code>	Integer	Sum positive votes for a community <b>post</b> .
<code>negativeVotes</code>	Integer	Sum negative votes for a community <b>post</b> .
