

 - □ (even less ones)
- □ They often use a search engine
- □ They get pointers to non-gov sites
- □ Happy with what they get

2nd Try...

- □ Why limit interactions?
 - avoid obscurity by default
 - move from ownership to stewardship

Open Government Data

"Public Sector Information (PSI) in free open raw formats and ways that make it accessible to all and allow reuse"

more specific? ex. see the 8 principles

Public Policy Outcomes

- Inclusion
- □ Transparency
- Accountability

Benefits

- Multiple views, not just one
- □ Reuse
 - "the coolest thing to do with your data will be thought of by someone else"
- □ Improved Web Search
- Data Integration
- □ Foster innovation


Victoria (AU) Budget Map
