### MEIG Rechartering

- MEIG charter ends on 30 April 2023 (extension needed cover the rechartering)
- Draft charter: <a href="https://w3c.github.io/media-and-entertainment/charters/charter-2023.html">https://w3c.github.io/media-and-entertainment/charters/charter-2023.html</a>
- Key changes:
  - More realistic success criteria
    - Not all suggested outcomes are required for success
    - Participation can be via mailing list or GitHub issues
  - Change "adherence to" to "implementation of" in:
    - Engagement and coordination with other organizations in the media industry to promote implementation of W3C standards
  - Change "tighter support" to "improved support" in our mission statement "to achieve a tighter support of media services on the Web"
  - Added Audiovisual Media Formats For Browsers CG to list of W3C groups to coordinate with

#### Media Source Extensions

- V2 scope proposed limited to features already defined or agreed:
  - Codec switching
  - MSE in Workers
  - ManagedMediaSource proposal: <u>w3c/media-source#232</u> and <u>explainer document</u>
    - Make it easier for media web site authors to support streaming media playback on constrained capability devices
    - Allow User Agents to react to changes in available memory and networking capabilities
    - Reduce the power impact of MediaSource APIs
  - Priority bug fixes
- Not in scope for v2: WebCodecs integration: w3c/media-source#184

### **Encrypted Media Extensions**

- V2 features:
  - Add encryption scheme capability detection WICG draft
  - Add HDCP policy detection
  - See <a href="https://github.com/w3c/encrypted-media/milestone/5">https://github.com/w3c/encrypted-media/milestone/5</a>
- New issue: Interaction with <u>Clear-Site-Data HTTP header</u> <u>w3c/encrypted-media#503</u>
- Aim for FPWD during Q2/Q3 2023

#### Audiovisual Media Formats For Browsers CG

  - "The scope of this community group is to provide a forum to discuss features of open and commercial audio-visual media formats that are relevant with web-technologies used in browsers, TVs, and Smart TVs. In particular, this includes identifying and reporting if and how individual formats and their features are referenced, can be called from a web environment and query necessary information from a host system in meaningful ways. The interplay and synchronization among different formats is also considered"
