# Decisions on Future Work; Accessibility

## **Specific areas of possible work - Accessibility**

- DRM - the barrier across the door
- Extending WCAG and/or UAAG:
- authoring guidelines
- Maths, graphics, video, simulations, interactivity and navigation/wayfinding
- Accessibility in education (possible CG??)

# Decisions on Future Work; DRM

## **Specific areas of possible work - Human/Digital Rights Management**

- Accessibility and special needs: lifting the barrier across the door
- XML Sig/Enc - converge on a single system? JS API?
- Fingerprinting, social DRM
- Where do millipayments fit in?
- Long-term archiving
- Device Convergence: DRM in the browsers...?

# Decisions on Future Work; Metadata

## **Specific areas of possible work - Metadata**

- How to identify a digital object (cf. fingerprints)
- Annotations: architecture, social, interop (existing CG)
- Relationship between PRISM, JDF, ODRL+RightsML and other metadata, and HTML/Web
- Self-cataloguing ebooks
- User rights
