The RDA and its Launch

- The Research Data Alliance (RDA) is a newly formed organization to accelerate and facilitate research data sharing and exchange globally – using Internet constructs. Often the datasets are very large.
- Individual membership like the IETF is planned
- The RDA launch happened in Sweden in March 2013
 - Over 200 people from 31 countries attended
