# Lessons learned (1): Open data & closed wallets

- It's hard to "make" money with open data!
- Requirements:
  - A lot of patience;
  - Change in relevant legislation takes forever;
  - Slow availability of PSI (+ formats, documentation, reuse; policies)
  - 50 shades of 'open';
  - Secure sufficient working capital;
  - Consider alternative sources of income to survive the "Valley of Death" (custom work, subsidies); pending paying customers w.r.t. open data;

# Lessons learned (2): Open data & how government sees it


- Some government entities sell datasets to data brokers
- Insufficient budget to buy back enriched data / or to meet the real-time information needs of civil servants
- Result: government itself use extensively the free of charge data.be mash-ups..
- ..together with large companies with more than enough budget to afford paying for it

## A couple of conclusions and issues


- Communication on the implications of open data
- Lack of awareness, specifically at government level
- Once online, always online
- A lot of issues on source data, master data, data conflicts -Data.be had to 'flow reverse engineer to avoid conflicts (addresses amongst other things)
- Things change.. Think of a real reconnaissance in 1914 / 2015
- Right to be forgotten is rotten
- Minimize conflicts between government itself and users
- Stress the added value of opening up data and information



## The Framework







#### Three general business models:



**Freemium**: you provide an "added value" data product or service, for which you charge: (eg. API, premium filters, alerts; <a href="https://opencorporates.com/">https://opencorporates.com/</a>)

**Cross subsidy**: you reach more customers, or provide enhanced services to existing customers, through wider sharing and use of your data; <a href="http://geolytix.co.uk">http://geolytix.co.uk</a>

**Network effects**: by collaborating with other organisations, you reduce your costs in maintaining data which you use in your work or extend the possible audience for your products and services: <a href="http://www.openstreetmap.org">http://www.openstreetmap.org</a>




