- Digital library platform for biblical studies
 - 40k+ books, including texts in Greek, Hebrew, Aramaic, Latin, Ugaritic, ...
 - Windows and Mac clients; mobile; browser
- Key functionality
 - Reading, search
 - Automated aggregation and reporting
 - Hyperlinked information within our platform

Editorial Annotation

- Linguistic analysis
 - Including contextual semantics
- Alignment across languages
 - Map from source languages to multiple modern works
- Curated reference data annotated on source texts

User Annotation Document Types

- Highlighting
- Notes
- Clippings (brief excerpts)
- Other specialized document types
 - Bibliography
 - Passage list
 - Word list
 - Prayer list

Using Annotation Documents

- Display through visual filters
- Export in various formats
- Share via social network (Faithlife.com)
- Display community annotations when reading

Areas of Interest for Open Annotation

- Standardized reference schemes
 - Including mappings between versions and editions
 - OSIS is a start (<http://www.bibletechnologies.net/>)
- Cross-lingual word-level alignment
- Semantic annotation of domain-specific datasets
- Bibliographic references
- Import annotations from the web or other platforms
