WoT WG deliverables

- Normative specifications
 - WoT Architecture
 - Thing Description
 - Scripting
 - Test Cases, interoperability
- Informative specifications and documents
 - Protocol Bindings
 - Use cases, requirements
 - Security recommendations (normative parts are built in the specifications)
 - Test suite and implementation reports
 - Primer and Best Practices documents

● Implementations

“The Working Group expects to provide open source implementations for the specifications.”

Implementation(s) as Deliverable

WG Charter says, under “Success Criteria”:

... each specification is expected to have at least two independent implementations of each of feature defined in the specification.

Under “Other Deliverables” the WG Charter also says:

The Working Group expects to provide open source implementations for the specifications.

W3C Software and Document license

“Permission to ***copy, modify, and distribute this work, with or without modification, for any purpose and without fee or royalty*** is hereby granted, provided that you include the following on ALL copies of the work or portions thereof, including modifications:

- The full text of this NOTICE in a location viewable to users of the redistributed or derivative work.
 - Any pre-existing intellectual property disclaimers, notices, or terms and conditions. If none exist, the W3C Software and Document Short Notice should be included.
 - Notice of any changes or modifications, through a copyright statement on the new code or document such as "This software or document includes material copied from or derived from [title and URI of the W3C document]. Copyright © [YEAR] W3C® (MIT, ERCIM, Keio, Beihang)."
