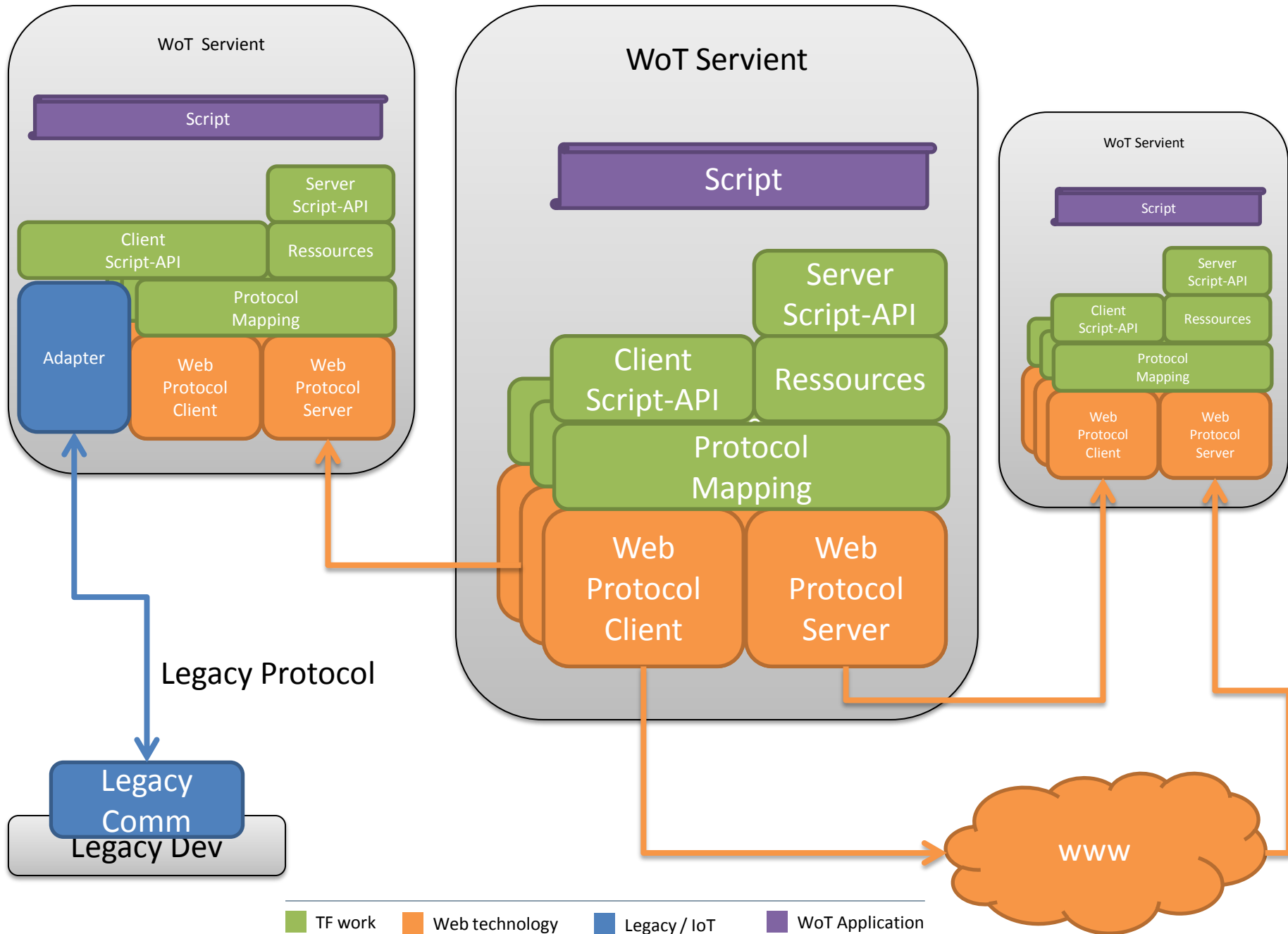

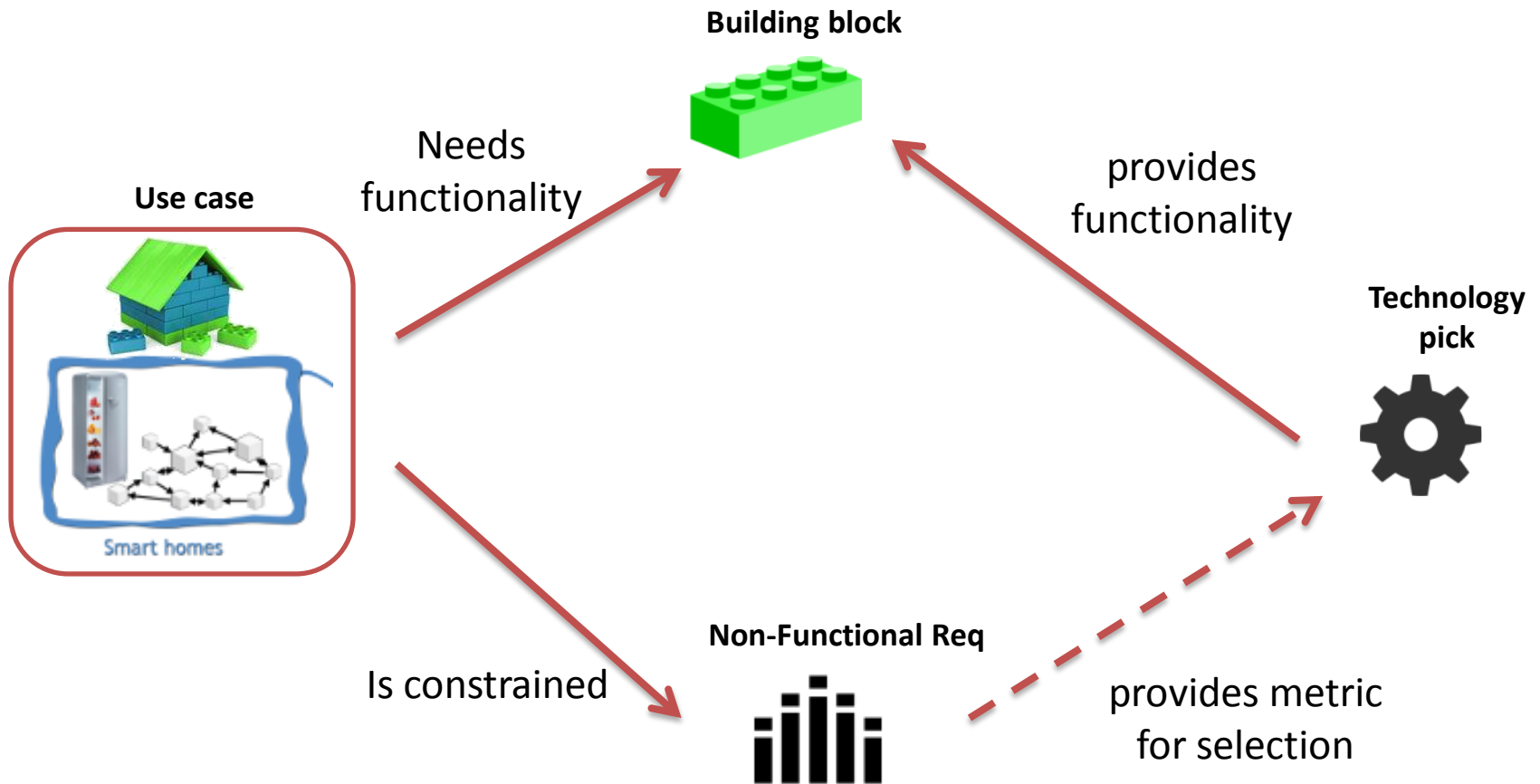
Architecture Model

Abstract Resource Model for Things

Web Thing model

- Properties
 - Static or dynamic properties of the Thing
- Actions
 - Invocable actions on a thing
 - May or may not result in state change
- Subscriptions/Event Sources
 - Intention to be notified on a certain condition

Web Thing model by example

Imagine a coffee machine

- Properties
 - Fill level of Water
 - Number of cups served
 - Brewing Temperature
 - Coffee Prices
- Actions
 - Brew
 - Clean run
 - Refund
- Subscriptions/Event Sources
 - Coffee poured
 - Service interval
 - Money inserted
