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



L2 MULTILINGUALS

▶ **Generating L2-English Index**

- Produce L2 Index table
- Produce L2 Senses table

▶ **Editing L2 Index**

- Include/Exclude HW in L2 Index
- Include/Exclude Sense (checkbox in Tree preview)
- Edit L2 HW and POS
- Edit the Entry (modify, add, remove, re-order Senses)
- Search Sense in English HW or Definition and add it

▶ **Translating Multilingually**

- Link L2 HW via each English Sense to translations in all other languages (of the English multilingual)
