Charter and Scope

- IG chartered on 07/21/2014 until 12/31/2016
- Goal is to formulate and steer social standardization across W3C and with other standards bodies/communities
- Scope includes harvesting and producing use cases that illustrate non-technical requirements for federated social web and social business

Deliverables

- Use case and requirements report
- Social architecture report (Possible)
- Social vocabularies inventory (Possible)

Membership

- 25 members
- 19 participants from 11 organizations
- 6 invited experts

Process

- Bi-weekly phone/IRC IG meetings
- Task force meetings as called by TF leaders
- Frequent communication via public mailing list
- 1-3 F2F meetings per year
- All activities documented on IG wiki

Status

- 5 official meetings since chartered
- 4 tasks forces formed
- Use Case TF has met twice (virtually)
- Harvested scenarios and use cases from previous groups' efforts
- Created first version use case template
- Created first version use case categorization
- First draft of some full use cases written

Example use cases

- Social profile creation
- Federation of profile information to a new social network or system
- Social profile updates
- Social profile deletion

Next steps

- Revise draft use cases and share again with Social WG
- Continue to collect scenarios and develop into full use cases
- Revise and expand categorization
- Catalog relevant vocabularies
- Document social architecture
