
Chinese W3C participation survey analysis

* The most interested work group is HTML/CSS and WebRTC




Q4: what do you think about the current status of Chinese companies attending the W3C

- * Language is a big problem




Q7: How to inspire Chinese companies to attend W3C activity?

- * Other problem includes member fee and F2F meeting is too short.




Q9 & Q10
