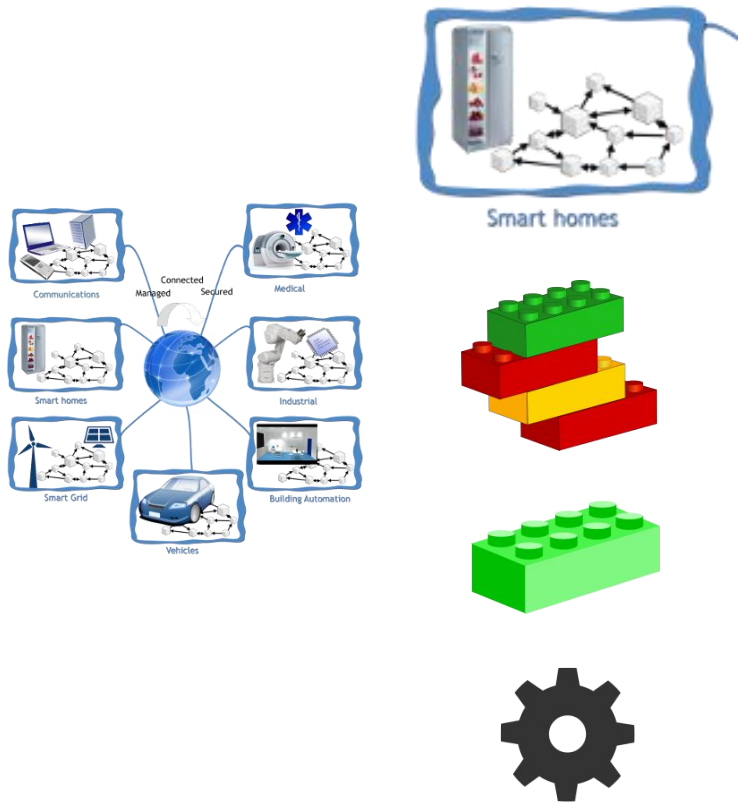

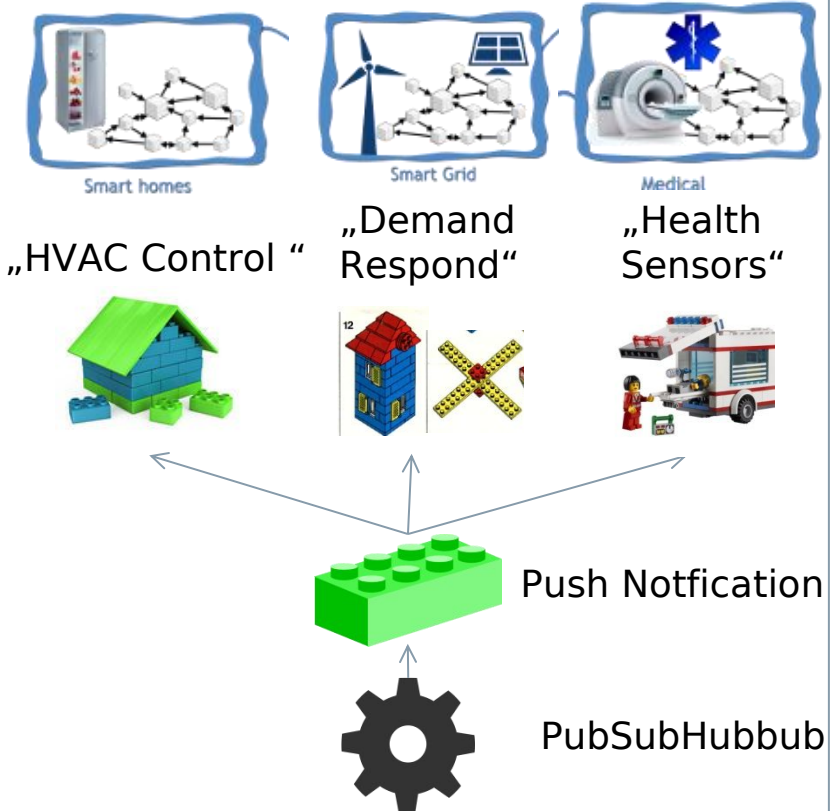

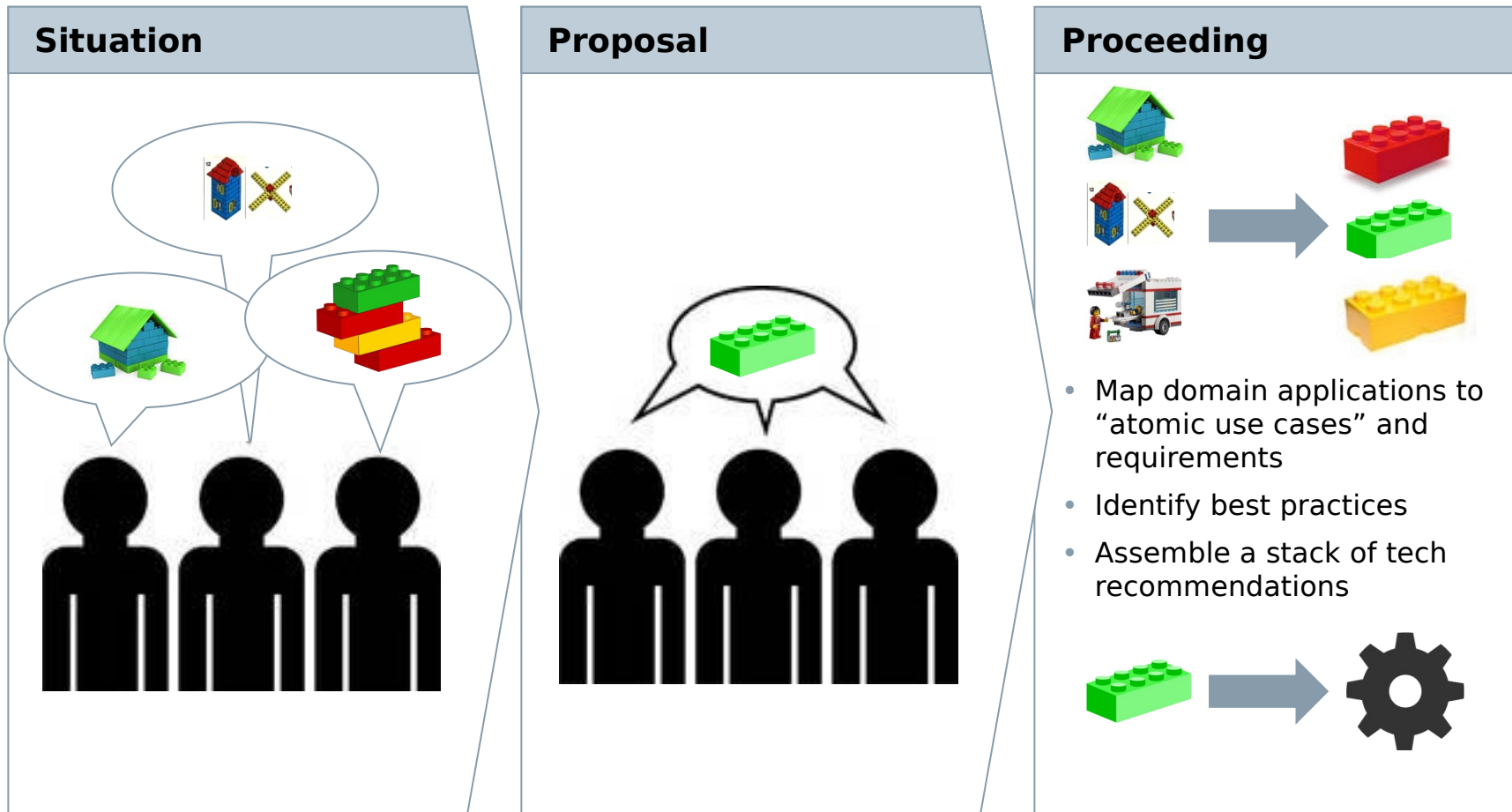
Drill Up: Atomic Use Case
